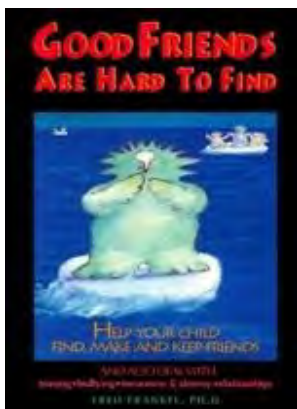
June 17: Nick Digiacco, Forestry Information services, presenting on the forest AND the trees.
